Taxi fares in Toronto for one to four passengers:

- for the first 0.143 km or part thereof: \$3.25
- for each additional 0.143 km or part thereof: \$0.25
- for waiting time while under engagement, for each 29 seconds: \$0.25
- for each additional passenger in excess of four: \$2.00

TTC fares in Toronto:

Riders will need a ticket, token, pass, transfer or exact cash. A "proof of payment" system is operating on most streetcar lines; details vary by route. Daily and weekly passes are available at subway stations.

- the single cash fare is \$3.25 for a one-way bus, subway or streetcar trip (\$2.10 senior)
- a day pass is \$12.50 per person (day pass can be used for two adults on holidays and weekends)
