By air: Canadian North (AKT) is the sole carrier throughout Nunavut.

It is cheaper to <u>book connecting flights through Canadian North</u> when possible. https://canadiannorth.com/

Inuit-owned Canadian North is a member of Aeroplan.



## Ottawa-Iqaluit

Flights usually twice-a-day by economy-class only Boeing 737-700.

The distance is 2,100 km and the flying time 3 hr. 10 min.

The current cheapest fare is \$1,115 saver fare, non-refundable.

#### Montreal-Iqaluit (via Kuujjuaq)

Flights twice-a-week

#### **Edmonton-Iqaluit** (via Yellowknife and Rankin Inlet)

Flights three-times-a-week by Boeing 737-700 (this distance is only  $\underline{1,990 \text{ km}}$ ; via Ottawa it is  $\underline{3,800 \text{ km}}$ , almost exactly twice the distance!)

## Iqaluit-Nuuk (Greenland)

Flights once-a-week by Air Greenland between Iqaluit and Nuuk.
