TRANSPORTATION

By air: **Canadian North** (AKT) is the sole carrier throughout Nunavut.

It is cheaper to book connecting flights through Canadian North when possible.

Inuit-owned Canadian North is a member of *Aeroplan*.



Ottawa-Iqaluit

Flights usually twice-a-day by economy-class only Boeing 737-700.

The distance is **2,100 km** and the flying time 3 hr. 10 min.

The current cheapest fare is \$1,115 saver fare, non-refundable.

Montreal-Iqaluit (via Kuujuaq)

Flights twice-a-week

Edmonton-Iqaluit (via Yellowknife and Rankin Inlet)

Flights three-times-a-week by Boeing 737-700 (this distance is only 1,990 km; via Ottawa it is 3,800 km, almost exactly twice the distance!)

Iqaluit-Nuuk (Greenland)

Flights once-a-week by Air Greenland between Iqaluit and Nuuk.

Local: **Caribou Tuktu Cabs**, flat rate of \$9 currently, you may be required to share your journey with other travellers going in the same direction.
